Speaker

John Fergusson was born on a large family farm in Wiltshire, UK. After earning a degree in Agriculture, he came to New Zealand in 1969 where he worked as a scientist at the DSIR in Palmerston North. During that time, he met his wife Bron. They married in 1976 and returned to UK where he worked on the family farm. In 1979 they encountered God and became Christians. In 1984, John was filled with the Holy Spirit in a big tent meeting of Reinhard Bonke. They returned back to their farm and started various home groups and Bible studies. Six years later they sold their farm and moved into full-time ministry where they served as International Campaign Directors for German evangelist, Reinhard Bonke. They served in this role for 7 years organising gospel events around the world. In 2005, they returned back to New Zealand and have been here ever since where they have been involved in teaching and preaching as well as writings books. John and Bron also lead mission teams to Nepal twice a year.

I stitched prayers in with some of the work, especially the French Knots, as I had the feeling I was anchoring those prayers and giving them real substance. I am continuing with the village, and have made a thatched cottage, and am presently working on the Country House. I am also continuing with the tatting lace making a few things for a friend overseas.
