Being a cat lover myself I couldn't help smile that they baked a cake for their cat when it returned after being missing for 3 weeks:


Here's Nick with the cat as a kitten!! On his knee:



Tessa loves working with the people of 'A', over 10,000 people who are fighting to reclaim their land from the government. She appreciates their hard work, organisation and that they haven't relied on foreign funding or outside money to achieve most of what they have done. The biggest challenge is dealing with internal conflicts and some difficult leaders who are seeking power more than seeking peace and the good of the people.



Nick said he loves working with amazing health workers, including inspirational nurse Emma (see photo of Emma) who manages to be the youth mobiliser for the whole diocese, manages a health center in the youth prison while also managing OneDay Health in Gulu!



## MISSION MATTERS - Cont.

He is also loving the rapid expansion of OneDay Health – we now have relationships with 4 Anglican Diocese, and have launched 25 health centers in remote places and by the end of the year should have over 30! The most challenging part this year has been movement restrictions with coronavirus, slowing down our work considerably.
