
## **CHRISTMAS EVE - FUN FOR EVERYONE**

Development Trust has been working
through its local groups to help Tongans
recover after last year's eruption and
tsunami. It is running psychosocial training
so people can help those living with loss
and trauma.

Our partner the Department of Service to Palestinian Refugees plans to distribute emergency relief and rebuild its Primary Health Clinics and Vocational Training Centres as soon it is safe. As a member of ACT Alliance – Action by Churches Together – we work together to provide practical help to people after disasters and in places of conflict.

On this Christmas Day we celebrate the love we find in Christ with the world.
